



Suspected New World Screwworm Sample Collection and Submission

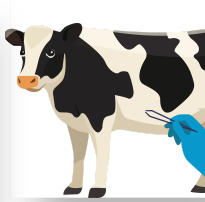
NWS sample submissions must include a Foreign Animal Disease (FAD) number for official identification.

Step 1



Wear gloves for personal protection

Step 2



Collect intact & active larvae samples from multiple parts of the wound with tweezers

Step 3



Place larvae in a vial or container with ethanol or isopropyl alcohol

Step 4



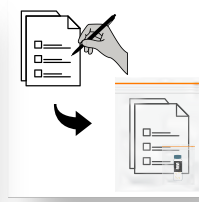
Label the vial with collection information and location

Step 5



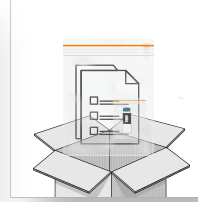
Place the container in a 4"x6" or other plastic bag and seal

Step 6



Place the completed collection form & bagged container in a 9"x12" or other plastic bag

Step 7



Place the sealed 9"x12" bag in a shipping box

Step 8



Tape the box securely & drop it off with the designated courier to submit the sample

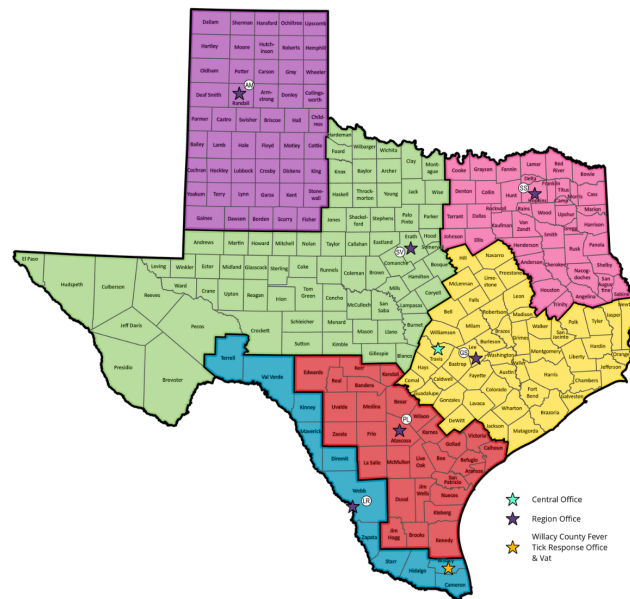
